ACCOMMODATION TAX

Dear Guest,

From the 20.03.2018 the Town of Castiglione d'Orcia has imposed an accommodations tax, through the resolution of the Town Board n. 102 on the 12/12/2017.

The tax is intended to finance strategies to support the tourism, including the ones of the support to the accommodation structures, to the maintenance, restoration, use and recovery of the cultural and environmental heritage together with the public, local services.

The tax is applicable at every person and for every night, **up to a maximum of 30 overnight stays** in the calendar year (even if not consecutive, regardless of the tourist facilities in which you stay).

The **amount of tax is Euro 1,00 (one) per person per night** and must be paid to the proprietor that issues a receipt for it.

The following **exemptions** are considered:

- a) people resident in Castiglione d'Orcia;
- b) the minors up to twelve years old;
- c) the severely disabled, whose disability status is certified in accordance with art. 3 paragraph 3 of Law No. 104/92 and similar provisions of the countries of origin for foreign citizens;
- d) person accompanying handicapped;
- e) employee (public or private) for a period of not less than 6 consecutive days, for service reasons;
- f) the people that stay in tourist properties following measures established by the public authority because of emergency situations due to natural disasters or particular events or for humanitarian purposes;
- g) volunteers who provide service in case of calamity;
- h) the staff belonging to the State Police and to the Armed Forces who does public security activities.
